



BARBARA MORLEY FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

In an effort to expose more youths to art as a creative outlet, The West Hartford Art League, through a donation from The Barbara Morley Family Foundation, is offering scholarships to underserved youths ages 5-18 from the Greater Hartford region.

Scholarships will be granted for classes in our fall, winter, spring and summer sessions based on need and income documentation. The scholarship will cover a portion of class and materials cost. Preference will be given to new applicants who have not previously received funding. Individuals may apply for up to two scholarships per academic year (fall, winter spring, summer), however in an effort to reach as many students as possible, an applicant may not apply for two scholarships during the same session. Non-members may apply, however if a non-member is awarded a scholarship and then wishes to apply for a subsequent scholarship, the applicant must first become a WHAL member. A completed application for a scholarship must be submitted to the WHAL office at least two weeks before the first class meeting.
